#### EDUCATION DONATIONS:

Story books – for all ages, but especially illustrated children's books (in Spanish)  
Music for children and Educational Videos/DVDs for youth/adults – all subjects (in Spanish)  
Planning, reference, and text books for students and teachers – all subjects (in Spanish)  
Teacher supply store posters, maps, diagrams, fine motor control toys – all subjects  
Dictionaries (in Spanish), alphabets, numbers – picture/word versions and hands-on objects  
Math games, geometry sets, brain teasers, science experiments, calculators, abacuses  
Arts & crafts, plasticine, simple games, puzzles, lego blocks in containers  
Paper, binders, notebooks, sketch books, colouring books, construction paper  
Pens, pencils, sharpeners, erasers, masking tape, crayons, makers, chalk, sharpies, markers

#### HEALTH DONATIONS:

The book Donde No Hay Doctor ("Where There Is No Doctor" Spanish edition)  
Pharmaceutical supplies – over-the-counter, in containers  
Blood pressure cuffs, nurse and doctor office equipment  
Eyeglasses labeled with corrective vision measurement  
Wheelchairs, walkers, crutches  
Toothbrushes, toothpaste, and dental office equipment  
Complete First Aid Kits, personal hygiene products and supplies in containers  
Clothing – shoes, jeans, shorts, shirts, sun dresses – all clothing clean, no stains or rips
